Pet Costume Contest Rules

General

- Participation donation of \$10 is suggested. All proceeds raised will be donated to All Things Wild Rehabilitation in Georgetown, Texas.
- Event officials reserve the right to refuse entry and/or excuse aggressive dogs from the event area.
- Registration forms must be filled out completely.
- Please provide a legible and thorough description of your pet and its costume.
- The announcer will use this information to announce your pet during the contest and information may be included in any post-event promotion, advertising and media. Be sure to sign the attached registration form.
- Most importantly, have fun! We strive to provide a safe environment for you and your pet and appreciate your cooperation.

All participating pets must be

- quiet and secured by a leash of six (6') feet or less at all times.
- kept approximately 10' (ten feet) away from other dogs during the event.
- social and friendly to all others, including other pets and people. Any act of aggression will result in being asked to leave the judging area. Please note, this rule also applies to owners/handlers.
- with its owner/handler at all times. Pets may not be left unattended and/or tethered to any fixture.
- up-to-date on all vaccinations and licensing as required by the State of Texas and/or Williamson County. Proof of rabies vaccination is required (documentation or current tag) at the event.
- clean and appear to be in good physical and mental health.
- spayed, neutered OR not in heat.
- comfortable and at-ease with crowds, other pets and noisy environments.

Owners/Handlers will be

- social and friendly to all others, including other pets and people. Any act of aggression will result in being asked to leave the judging area. Please note, this rule also applies to pets.
- held responsible for the actions of their dogs.
- comfortable and at -ease with crowds, other pets and noisy environments.
- provided a participant number which shall be worn in a way that it is visible to the judges.
- at the judging area at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest.
- acknowledge and agree that the judges' decisions are final.
- expected to pick up after your pet.

By registering for the pet costume contest, permission and consent is given to the use of any form of documentation created of this event (including photographs, audio/visual, etc.) to Downtown Georgetown Association and/or Wag Heaven who may publish and/or use for promotional purposes.
